Highlights from the December Vestry Meeting

- Bradley announced that Anna Burman, Greg McClure, Charlie Shook and Aaron Sims have agreed to run for Vestry.
- The Vestry continued discussion of the 2020 budget. There are still several variables including total pledges, other income and staffing questions.
- Gayle Ennis discussed new "Safeguarding" policies form the Diocese of Indianapolis. Each congregation is asked to create its own policy using the Diocesan policy as a guide. The goal is to protect members of our churches, especially those who might be particularly vulnerable to abuse.
- St. John's has been offered the donation of a Steinway grand piano for use in the nave. The Vestry was very appreciative of this generous gift.
- Bradley announced that Kaitlin Curtice, author of Glory Happening, has accepted our invitation to be at St. John's on May 9 and 10. More information will be coming soon.
- Because of scheduling difficulties, the January vestry meeting will be moved back one week to Jan. 15.
